

## Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

The period of consultation has ended. This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed 28 days from the date of this notice. This decision notice meets the duty to consult and notify when removing street trees set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021

<b>Decision summary</b>	Tree to be removed as it is a self-sown, multi-stemmed tree that is inappropriate for its location. Pruning is not considered an option with this tree due to the fast growing nature of the species. To make up for the loss of the tree we are aiming to plant two replacements on the grass verge nearby during the winter period.
